This Visiting Professorings (VPP) assignment is very positive. It's my first time in the Philippines and I'm impressed with the level of competence that PhilDev team has shown. Technological Institute of the Philippines (TIP) faculty, administration, and students were also very hospitable. Filipinos are very warm. I'm leaving Manila with a pit in my stomach; similar to what I feel whenever I leave home in Nairobi going back to the US.

I found out that engineering students in TIP are very creative. Their orientation is to innovate products that benefit the community. While the internet-based innovations are tempting, TIP engineering students create practical products that benefit the society.

For the professors and the TIP administration, they're very receptive to what I have recommended to dig deeper on adding entrepreneurship component to the already strong engineering curriculum knowing that TIP is one of two universities in the Philippines that is ABET-accredited, aside from Mapua. I'm also glad that we were able to instill to TIP the importance of sustainability with what we started.

I'm bringing back with me to University of Florida the draft MOU between UF and TIP for a long-term partnership. The days I spent with TIP were very productive. This is also an experiential learning for me. Kindly extend my appreciation to the PhilDev Trustees and USAID.
